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REFLECTION OF SPIRITUAL AND EDUCATIONAL REFORMS IN THE STATE INNOVATIVE DEVELOPMENT IN NEW UZBEKISTAN

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Annotation: The priority mechanisms of the state innovation policy, integrated conceptual theoretical developments, priorities and current tasks of practical proposals and recommendations for their implementation are considered in the process of ensuring spiritual growth. Man's perfection is reflected in the knowledge and skills he acquired in his youth, and the image of the state is reflected in the reforms he is carrying out in the world community. Of course, these reforms must be carried out by a political leader who has his own views and will. In this regard, the President emphasized "As a result of our largescale measures for the political, social and economic modernization of society, a new Uzbekistan is being formed. Today, democratic changes in our country have become irreversible. "[1] In order to make these reforms more effective in creating a new image of our society, there is a need for integrated conceptual theoretical developments for the formation and improvement of the current system of innovative principles and optimization of its renewal mechanism, as well as practical proposals and recommendations. At the present stage of development of Uzbekistan, a new stage of development has begun in our country, that is, the period of creating a new image of society. In this regard, large-scale reforms are being carried out and many innovations are reflected in all spheres of life. A new Uzbekistan based on the paradigms of sustainable development, a competitive and open socio-economic space for the outside world, is being built across the country.

In addition, over the years, whether it is a leader or an ordinary specialist worker, working with citizens has led to a passive culture of dealing with citizens. In this regard, the priorities for the radical improvement of the system of spiritual and educational work have been identified: a healthy outlook in society and the promotion of the idea of "From national revival to national progress" based on the principles of goodness and

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humanity, turning creativity into a nationwide movement; ensuring the continuity of spiritual education in the family, educational institutions and communities; propaganda - the organization of propaganda and educational work on a scientific basis, increasing the effectiveness of scientific and methodological research in the field, the introduction of a system of continuous monitoring aimed at strengthening the stability of the sociospiritual environment; implementation of comprehensive measures aimed at eliminating such evils as indifference to the fate of the people, localism, tribalism, corruption, disregard for family values and irresponsibility in the upbringing of young people; enhancing the culture of the population's use of the World Wide Web, strengthening the ideological immunity of the population against ideological and information attacks; to achieve the supremacy of culture, literature, cinema, theater, music and art of all kinds, publishing - printing products, spiritual and moral criteria in the media, national and universal values; Regular study of geopolitical and ideological processes, effective ideological fight against terrorism, extremism, bigotry, human trafficking, drug trafficking and other dangerous threats, as well as the development of international cooperation in this area (4).

Of course, the result of our efforts in this area is to make a democratic state with a strong civil position, which is in line with modern innovative trends in the formation of a new image of our country, by 2030 among the 50 strongest developed countries in the world. Resolution No. PQ-3365 "On measures to strengthen and develop innovative activities" is extremely important for the policy of the state to ensure the innovative development of the country.
