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IN RUSSIAN AND KOREAN LINGUOCULTUROLOGY

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Annotation. This article is devoted to the concept of "Time" in Russian and Korean. The article allows you to deeply understand the specifics of the definition of the concept of "time" in the Korean and Russian languages, to rethink the similarities and differences in the mentality of the two cultures.

Keywords. Time, interval, period of time, time, period, moment, term, occasion.

In linguoculturology, the concept of "time" is a universal concept that has an identical semantic structure in Korean and Russian. The concept of "time" is a complex phenomenon that reflects numerous aspects of human life and society, since it is associated with self-awareness, regulation of behavior and activity, both individual and group. The problems of international relations that exist at the present stage require research in the field of intercultural understanding, one of which, in our opinion, is the study of mental images and behavioral strategies associated with the category of time.

In Russian, the object under study is denoted by the concept of "time". In the explanatory dictionary of the Russian language S.I. Ozhegov and N.Yu. Shvedova, the following definitions of "time" are given: 1) one of the forms of existence of matter; 2) the duration of something, measured in seconds, minutes, hours; 3) consecutive change of hours, days, years; 4) a certain moment at which something happens; 5) period, era; 6) time of day, year; 7) a suitable time, auspicious moment; 8) period or moment free from something; 9) the category of the verb, in special forms referring the action to the plan of the present, past or future. In the explanatory dictionary of T.F. Efremova gives definitions that are synonymous with the above, and one more thing is added: an indicator of the speed of an athlete when running, swimming for a certain distance. In the dictionary of D.N. Ushakov, no new definitions for this concept were found. The ABBYY Lingvo dictionary also has definitions for the lexeme "time":1) a period of time intended for a certain activity; 2) the length of time during which any processes, events occur; 3) the moment of the action; 4) historical period of time. It can be concluded that the most common definitions of the concept of "time" are: interval, duration, moment.

Let us consider the synonymous series of these definitions, since synonymy is one of the main language means reflecting the results of conceptualization processes. In the dictionary of Russian synonyms and expressions similar in meaning to N. Abramov, we find words that are close in meaning, such as: duration, moment, time, epoch, period, period of time, season, century, era, date. Among these definitions, we also note "duration", "interval" and "moment". Therefore, they are the dominants of the synonymic series.

But, despite their synonymy, these definitions of the concept "time" do not replace each other in all contexts without exception, for example: "I have time" (but not: "I have a moment / duration / interval"); "Right moment); "For a long time!" long period). Indeed, we can observe the phenomenon of the proximity of words, explained through their semantic meaning. According to the dictionary of S.I. Ozhegov "duration-time of flow, something", "interval - space or time separating something", "moment - a moment, an instant, a short time in which something happens." These interpretations are realized through the given examples: "Life expectancy. Miss the moment." As you can see, all definitions contain the word "time", which undoubtedly proves their semantic closeness. In Korean, the concept of "time" is denoted by two hieroglyphs "시각", that is, according to the ABBYY Lingvo dictionary, time, a period of time. In the explanatory dictionary of the Korean language, the following definition of time is given:

1. time; time; period; moment; instant
