NEW AGE HAMSHOLOGY AND PERFECTION EDUCATION

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Annotation.

This article examines the topic of education for perfection in the monograph "The perfect man - the ideal of literature" by the famous Navoi scholar, Doctor of Philology, Professor M. Muhiddinov.

A number of studies on the meaning of the education of perfection and mystical love are being created. The famous Navoi scholar Muslihiddin Muhiddinov's monograph "The perfect man - the ideal of literature" has a special significance in the modern anthology.
