

NATIONAL ANTHEM IN THE WORKS OF BOTIR ERGASHEV

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Annotation.

This article deals with the main theme of the work of the famous poet Botir Ergashev - the motherland, the homeland, the love of the country, motherly love, a worthy inheritance to great ancestors and a sense of national identity.

Well-known poet Botir Ergashev's poetry is based on works on patriotic themes. There are some complex aspects of writing poetry about the country. Therefore, it is very difficult to say anything new about the love of the motherland, its history, great ancestors. The poet has a very strong sense of national pride, he tries to avoid general descriptions, insensitive statements, all the learned parables. His poem "Our Flag" praises our flag, which is a symbol of independent Uzbekistan. The poem begins as follows:

Hilpiratar always blows the hurricane,
His desire is equal to paradise, beautiful.
These words are an expression of my pride -
Our flag is the most beautiful on earth.

Our Uzbek people love and respect the people they love, saying that they are "warm and beautiful." The poet uses an extremely beautiful allegory, saying that the flag of a nation should be loved and cherished as a human being, that it is an expression of national identity and national pride. The "Wind of Hurlik" is the long-awaited independence and freedom of our people.

Encyclopedia of Happiness - Chapter 1, Article 5 of the Constitution stipulates that the state symbols of the Republic of Uzbekistan - the flag, coat of arms and anthem - are approved by law.

As the President rightly said: "Nothing¹ in the great history goes unnoticed. It is preserved in the blood of nations, in their historical memory, and is manifested in their practical work. That is why he is powerful. Preservation, study and transmission of historical heritage from generation to generation is one of the most important priorities of our state policy.

In the conclusion of the poem, the idea of the flag of the country, which is a symbol of independence - the observations, scenes and situations become darker, the essence of excitement and heartbeat intensifies. The image of the flag is interpreted in harmony with the spirit of the time and the essence of human life and prospects:

We are ready for peace forever,
I wipe the dust off my face,
Let me be brave and say without fear,
Our flag is the most beautiful on earth.

According to the well-known literary scholar Ozod Sharafiddinov,

“Creation is a series of continuous discoveries. In order to unravel the mysteries of the old world, which is constantly moving, changing and renewing, it is necessary to constantly search for the creative, to discover new layers of the human heart, character, spiritual world. »

In Botir Ergashev's poetry, the relationship between thought and emotion is expressed in different ways, and philosophy is combined with the journalistic spirit. He takes a deep look at the process of events of that period with a new worldview. The bright, clear expression of love and devotion to the motherland encourages the reader to observe. In addition to evoking a certain mood and a sense of responsibility, these beautiful works about the homeland are subject to a brighter reflection of the main principle of the poem. His "O mother, my husband," "Mother is the motherland," "Vatan", "Liar mother", "Vatandormiz", "Vatanfurush bolam", "Great things await us! The main aesthetic credo of the poet's work is to express the bright future of the Motherland and the people in connection with the past and present in his poems, such as "Anthem of the Youth Union", "Our Flag". In the poem "Ona Vatan" he describes the love and sincerity in his heart as follows:

Let's call our motherland, motherland,
We are in love with both of them!
Mothers say, let the child serve the wind,
So, they gave birth to us for the Motherland!

For the well-known poet Botir Ergashev, the homeland is the most honorable and glorious concept in the world. glorifies with painful metaphors:

I swore to my mother,
My country, a lion in your soil, we suck in your sky.
If those who hold the flag are called flag bearers,
We are your compatriots!

With a sense of patriotism, the poet expresses the feelings of childhood, loyalty and love, civic duty and responsibility in his heart in a very natural, convincing and vivid way. In the poem "Anthem of the Youth Union" he wishes that devotion and devotion to the Motherland will become the essence of human life, that the younger generation will be worthy of the name of great ancestors:

From childhood he rode a wild horse,
Our grandfather Temur, who always won!
At the age of twelve he ascended the throne.
Our Babur grandfather who ruled the country!
To be a light face like our ancestors,
Let's shine, youth of Uzbekistan!
Let the world see the power of our youth,
Let's unite, youth of Uzbekistan!

One of the most important features of Botir Ergashev's poetry is that it reflects the dynamic life of modern Uzbekistan, creative reforms, the noble ideas facing the world in a wide range, in all colors and shades,² with a strong reputation. He reveals to the young reader the mysteries of today's globalizing, rapidly changing world, the meaning of life, the historical essence of the discoveries made by our great thinkers, inspires confidence in the heart of the bird, the light of tomorrow, encourages him to good deeds. :

Inherited from ancestors,
They lead the way to goodness,
Do not stop, compatriots,
Great things await us!
Give it every moment, adorn it,
Live the grief of tomorrow,
May Uzbekistan be great,
Great things await us!
