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DEVELOPMENT OF CREATIVE COMPETENCE OF STUDENTS ON THE BASIS OF TEACHING FOREIGN LANGUAGES (ON THE EXAMPLE OF PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION)

Creativity (lat., ing. "create" – creation," creative " – creator) - creative ability, which characterizes the individual's willingness to produce new ideas and is part of the personality as an independent factor. ¹³ It was also the basis for the development of science, which was based on teaching students creativity.

Creativity of the individual determines the person's Internal Resource, his transformation, his readiness to go beyond stereotypes, to find original non-standard solutions to complex problems, to successfully determine his place in society.¹⁴

Here in this place D.B.Bogoyavlenskaya emphasizes that creativity affects creative productivity, regardless of the general characteristic of the individual and the manifestation of his personal activity.¹⁵

The studies analyzed the interdependence and divergence aspects of creativity and intellectual abilities.

T.A.Barisheva and A.Yu.Jigalova in the opinion, development and manifestation are directly related to the level of Conscious Competence of a person in the field of creative activity in creativity. I.P. Osobov also connects pedagogical creativity with the competency, in accordance with the professional development of students. In this place, the interaction of professional development and pedagogical creativity in search of non-standard solutions in unusual situations, trying to prove that pedagogical creativity is the basis for the realization of its potential creativity in its independent manifestation, it emphasizes the possibility of acquiring knowledge and using them effectively, creatively, in social, professional situations. The formation and development of creative competence of students on the basis of teaching foreign languages in Professional education is a key factor in creative thinking, thinking of new ideas, encouraging them to achieve international achievements.

Creativeness of a person is manifested in his thinking, communication, feelings, certain types of activity.¹⁸ Therefore, creativeness is an important sign of iqtidor, which determines the mental acuity of students, along with ensuring active involvement in the educational process.

In fact, in the professional education system, on the basis of the teaching of foreign languages, the creative competence of students is formed by consistent reading and learning, working on their own, which gradually improves and develops.

In this foreign language plays an important role in the process of teaching foreign languages so that the teacher can direct the student to creative activity and organize this activity effectively.
